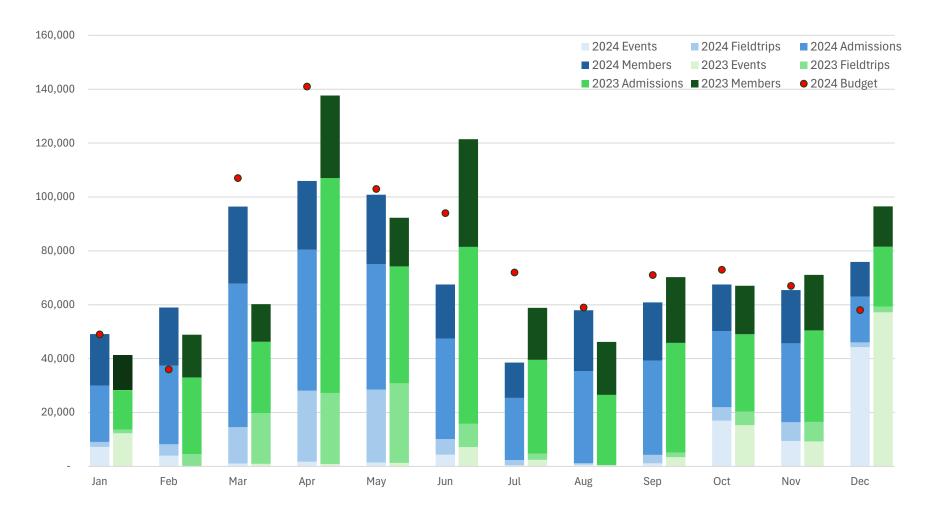

Approve and authorize release of retention withheld on construction services related to New Event Space for the following vendors:

Durham Construction - \$28,115.32
 C3 Electric - \$1,820.35
 GRAND TOTAL: \$29,935.67

DISCUSSION:

In accordance with the Retention Policy Adopted September 30, 2015, and Revised January 30, 2019, retention of 10% was withheld on Durham Construction and retention of 5% was withheld on C3 Electric for the Construction work for the New Event Space capital project.

Upon completion of a Fresno Chaffee Zoo project, the Zoo Corporation may request the release of any retention funds withheld for the project.

Prior to releasing any Retention Funds from the Escrow Account, ZooCorp shall request the release at an Authority Board meeting, at the same time presenting written certification that all conditions of the Escrow Agreement have been met, that the construction project is final and complete in accordance with the construction contract, and that the release of funds in the Escrow Account is appropriate. Such written certification shall include certification from the project architect or lead engineer that the project has been completed in accordance with the plans and specifications.

The Construction Project Manager has issued a letter certifying that all conditions of the escrow agreement have been met and that the project is final and complete in accordance with the construction contract, as described in the following pages. Due to the size and scope of this project, it did not require a project architect or an engineer, so that requirement is not applicable

to this project. Zoo Corporation staff consulted with Zoo Authority staff, who agreed with this conclusion.

Fresno's Chaffee Zoo Corporation Board of Directors approved this request at their meeting on March 13, 2025.

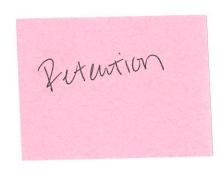
