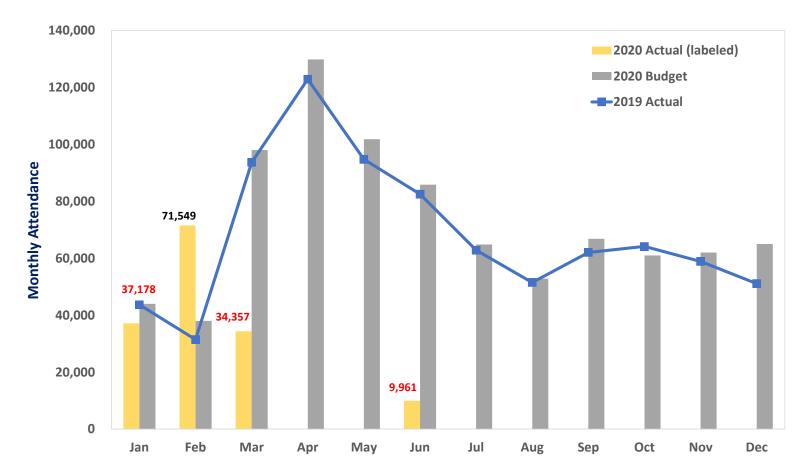
Key Takeaway: Self-generated revenue was \$3,444,298 below budget as of May 31, 2020

- (\$3,475,931) net surplus (more than triple the forecasted deficit)

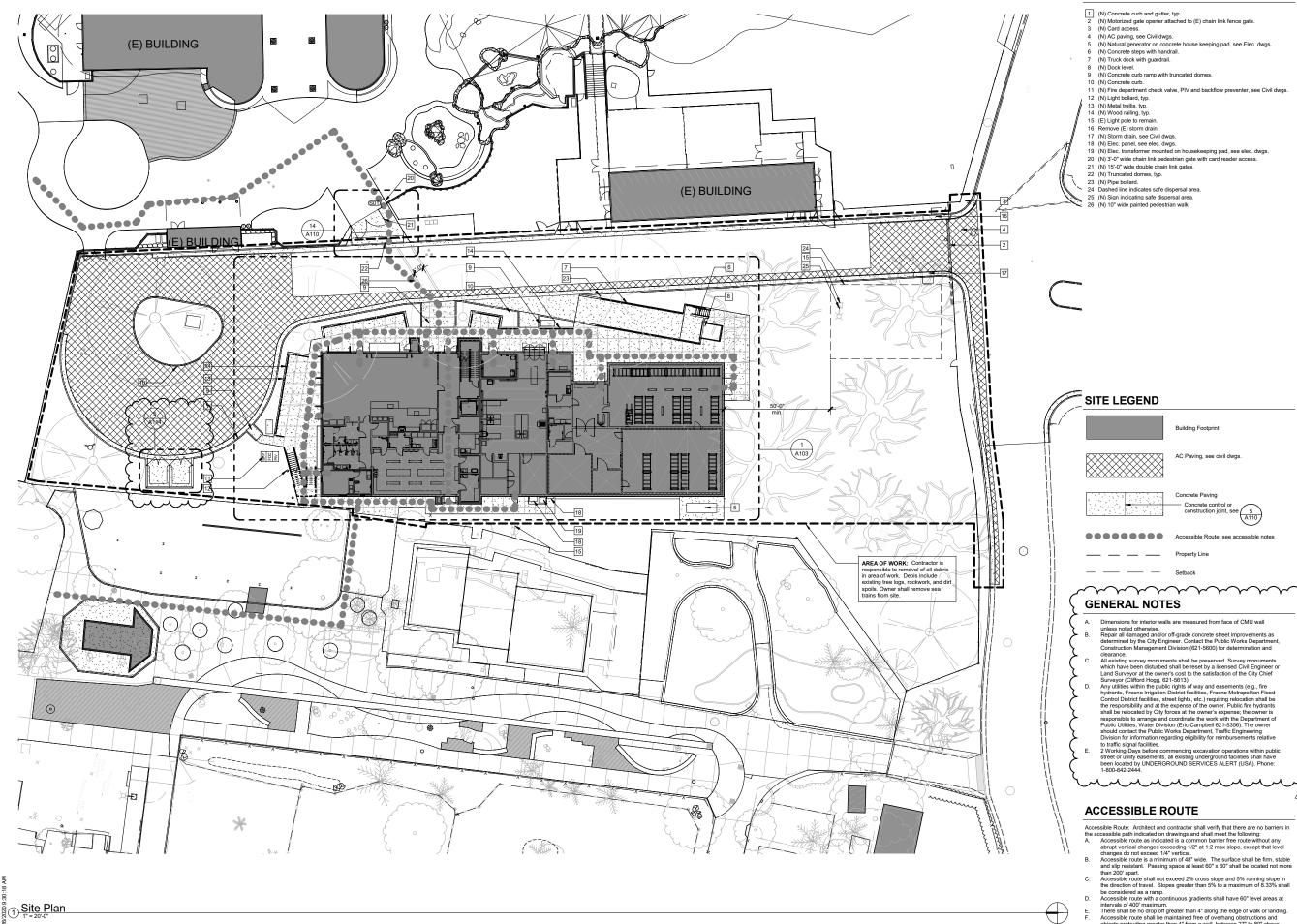

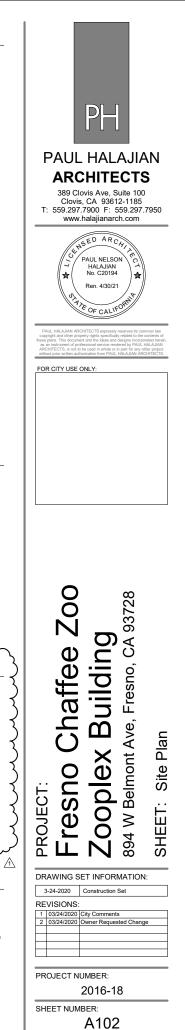
